Dear Sir/Madam,

After the July 1983 pogrom in Sri Lanka, you are aware that a number of Tamils arrived in Britain as Refugees and are afraid to return home.

Recently the British Government has taken the view that the situation in Sri Lanka has returned to normal and are refusing to accept their claims as Refugees.

Many Human Rights Organisations and Pressure Groups along with politicians are now fighting against the decision of the British Government. Tamil Information Centre is receiving large requests by Human Rights Organisation, Media and Politicians for information and comments on the present situation in Sri Lanka.

Last week the Eastern Eye of the IMT visited our Centre and interviewed us on the situation in Sri Lanka. This piece will be shown on Tuesday, the 7th of February, 1984 on Channel 4 at 11.00 P.M.
