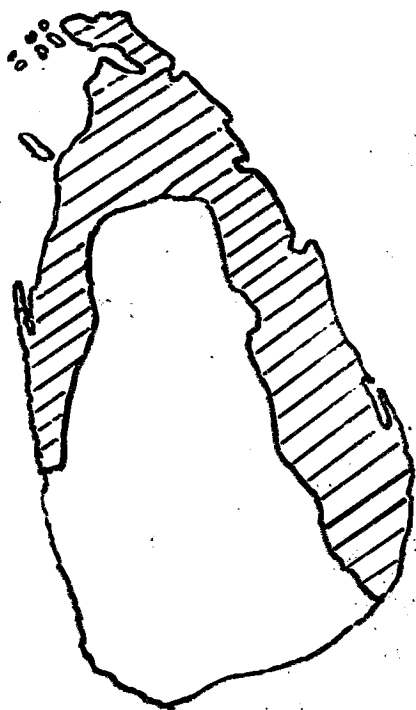
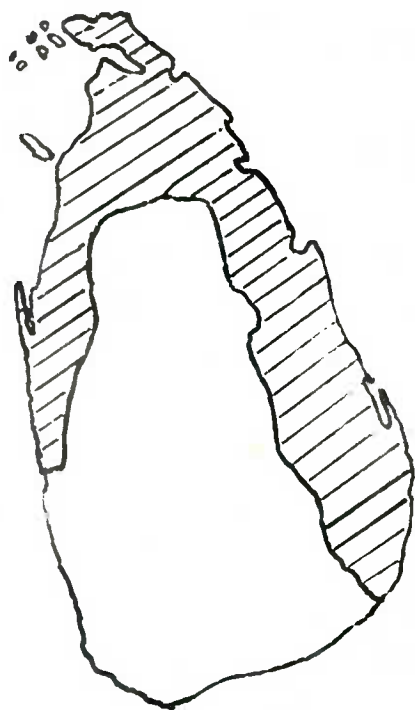

CONSTITUTION FOR KALAIPERUMANTRAM:

Tamil Liberation Organisation shall be the supreme political body underwhich three subsidiary institutions - T.R.O., K.P.M., & T.S.O. will function with relative autonomy whose activities are co-ordinated with T.L.O. Members of the T.L.O. leadership shall have representation in these associate bodies, while selected representatives from these bodies will be provided with participation in the desion making executive organ of T.L.O.

Kalaiperumantram will have a specific function of raising finance for the T.L.O. Since K.P.M. is the fund-raising organisation for the T.L.O., a co-ordination within the Finance Committee is of vital importance. The General Assembly of K.P.M. will elect a representative to the General Executive of T.L.O. in order to represent K.P.M. to the T.L.O. in the decision making executive.

Since K.P.M. is a subsidiary Organisation of T.L.O. and have a specific function of raising finance for T.L.O., all the members of K.P.M. will be T.L.O. members, and K.P.M. and K.P.M. will make use of every opotunity towards the growth of T.L.O.

Members of K.P.M. and the Finance Committee members of T.L.O. will collaborate and co-ordinate their activities in raising finance for the T.L.O. The members of the Finance Committee, for this purpose, will become members of K.P.M.

The members of K.P.M. will form a working committee of seven members of K.P.M.. This working committee becomes the decision making body of K.P.M. on matters affecting the organisation, espically financial matters.

The working committee of seven members will include members from K.P.M. and T.L.O. Finance Committee. Three members will be elected by the members of K.P.M. and four members will be appointed by the T.L.O. General Executive. This W.C. will meet whenever necessary

and decide on any matters affecting K.P.M. and any decision can be passed with a simple majority. Three should be a quorum of atleast five members in any meeting and for an urgent meeting a minimum of 24 hours notice should be given to its participants.

The W.C. should form sub-committees from the members of K.P.M. and each committee can be entrusted with a particular responsibility as the occasion arises.

There will be four signatories for signing cheques and three out of the four can authorise payment and there will be two from the Finance Committee and two from Kalaiperumantram.

This constitution is subject to amendment in a general meeting and it needs two third of majority.
